The 8th Annual Rocky Ripple Festival

Saturday, September 29th 11a.m. - 6p.m.

The eighth annual Rocky Ripple Festival will be held Saturday, September 29, 2007 from 11 am to 6 pm in Hohlt Park. This admission free event, sponsored by the Rocky Ripple Community Association, is the Rocky Ripple Community Association's major annual fundraiser for the town of Rocky Ripple's Park Endowment Fund. Bands will be scheduled throughout the day, with a variety of music - from bluegrass to folk, to contemporary and jazz. Artists will display and have for sale their works of art, covering the areas of ceramics, painting, graphics, watercolors, sculpture, photography, jewelry, clothing and more. Among children's activities will be entertainment, games and the opportunity to throw their own pots on a potter's wheel.

BACK THIS YEAR: The Broad Ripple Brew Pub will be serving beer and wine during the festival! So kick back and enjoy the music awhile longer! For those of you unfamiliar with the Brewpub, it is located in Broad Ripple by the Monon Trail.

The Community Association's mission for this event is to raise the community's awareness of the arts at a price that everyone can afford. Artists just getting started, or looking for smaller scale venues have a mechanism to display and sell their wares. Food and drinks will be sold during the festival by Rocky Ripple Community Association and Veterans Association volunteers. All proceeds benefit community activities.
