***Participants will get a workout while pushing boundaries and personal limits on the newly renovated Climbing Tower.***

The Climbing Tower has three sides: climbing, rappelling, and play pen. The climbing side has two routes accommodating beginner and advanced climbers. The rappelling side is designed for a unique individual lowering experience from the top of the tower. The play pen side is a series of obstacles to reach the top.

The High Course allows participants, 12 and older, a unique, challenging experience 38 feet about the ground. This course is designed to enhance self confidence, self-trust, and personal growth.
