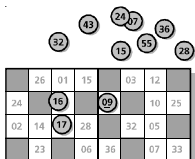
PLEASE DONATE BAKED GOODS

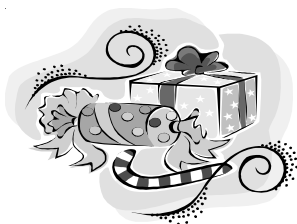
