

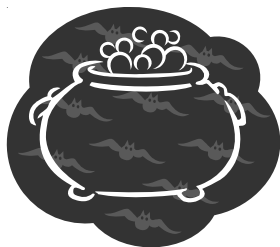

CHILI COOKOFF and Halloween Howl on October 20th



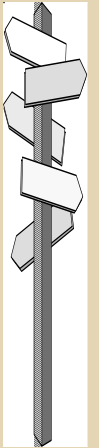

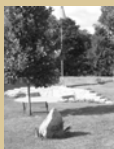

ROCKY RIPPLE FESTIVAL Our Biggest Success Yet - Thanks to All!

The eighth annual Rocky Ripple Festival, held Saturday, September 29, 2007 in Hohlt Park, again raised over \$2500 for the park endowment fund. It was the largest attendance ever, with over 1000 visitors. We also had the largest numbers of artist booths ever - 42!

Thanks to the efforts of Rocky Ripple residents Nathan France and Paul Redmond, the endowment funds raised at this year's festival went to work two days before the festival was held, with new mulch for the Hohlt Park playground.
