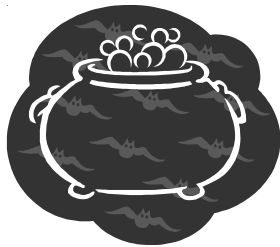

## CHILI COOKOFF and Halloween Howl on October 28th

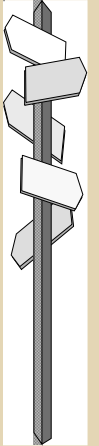
