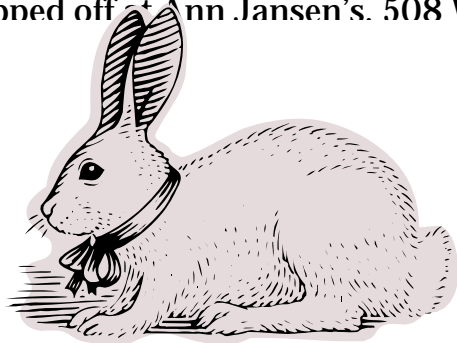
EASTER EGG HUNT AND CAKE WALK
